PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Eating or Drinking

FAILURE TO STRICTLY FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN ASPIRATION AND MAY BE FATAL.

For your anesthesia, it is extremely important that patients have an **empty** stomach for their procedure. Please follow these instructions carefully.

Under the age of 5:

- No solid foods for six (6) hours prior to appointment.
- Total of 4 oz. of water or apple juice ONLY may be taken up to four (4) hours prior to appointment time.
- Nothing may be taken by mouth for four (4) hours prior to appointment time.

Age 5 and older:

- No solid foods for eight (8) hours prior to appointment time.
- Total of 4 oz of water or apple juice ONLY may be taken up to four (4) hours prior to appointment time.
- Nothing may be taken by mouth for four (4) hours prior to appointment time.

Clothing

- Please wear comfortable clothing that includes a **short** sleeve shirt.
- Children should bring a light to medium blanket for the procedure and ride home.
- Please bring a change of clothing for children who do not wear a diaper or pull up.
- Do not wear makeup, nail polish, or false eyelashes.
- · Please remove contact lenses prior to your appointment.

Change in Health Status and Medications

- A change in health status, especially the development of a cold or fever, is extremely important. Please notify Dr. Tan, DDS immediately if there is any change in your child's or your health status.
- Prescription medications should be taken as scheduled unless previously indicated by Dr. Tan, DDS and may be taken only with minimal sips of water.

Designated Driver

- A responsible adult must accompany the patient to the office and remain throughout the appointment.
- Do not plan on driving or making decisions for the next twenty-four (24) hours after the administration of anesthesia.
- Please arrange to have a responsible adult spend the rest of the day with you or your child.
- Please provide car seats for your children.
